

Lesson Plan for the book PLAY!

30 minute lesson

Introduction:

The students are asked a warm-up question.

How do you like to play at your house?

Have you ever pretended to do a job? Which job? (Prompt if necessary with a picture walk through the book.)

Reading:

While the teacher reads the book she will ask students to raise their hands if they have ever played like the characters in the book.

Follow-up Activity:

Materials Needed: Paper Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils

Optional Materials:

Scissors, Glue, Yarn, Googly Eyes, Felt, Cloth, Construction Paper, Buttons, Other Embellishments

Use the attached paper doll outline and create a doll that represents an occupation or a model of how the child looks/dresses while they play. (If you cannot print the doll outline document the parent or child can simply draw a stick figure with a circle for a head on a piece of paper.)

If time allows the children can talk about their craft.
